Statement of Need/Program Overview

This symposium is intended to provide comprehensive updates on biology, diagnosis, screening, and management of cancer. Paradigm shift in the treatment options for cancer will be discussed. This program will facilitate interaction among oncologists, and researchers interested in development of novel therapeutics for cancer. In addition to multimodality therapy, adjuvant therapy, and targeted therapies, this symposium will present data on pharmacogenomics, and the role of individualized therapy of most promising emerging agents currently in development for the treatment of cancer.
